

FLORIDA COMMISSION ON HURRICANE LOSS PROJECTION METHODOLOGY

Meeting Summary¹ MARCH 15, 2000

1. The Commission approved:
 - A. The on-site review by the Professional Team of previously accepted models (AIR, E.W. Blanch, EQE and RMS). The scope of the review will consist of: An overview of the model relating to changes from the previously accepted version, review of the Standards with significant changes, gathering information on the inclusion of commercial residential property in the modeling process, and the improvement of the construction classifications to make them more hurricane-related rather than fire related,
 - B. The on-site review by the Professional Team of the two new models (Risk Engineering, Inc. and Applied Research Associates),
 - C. The Professional Team, in conjunction with staff, to identify and collect any information missing from the submissions. Once collected and the submission is complete, then proceed with the on-site review.

2. Legal Issues:

Cindy Gokel, FHCF attorney advised the Commission that she and members of the Commission have been approached about testifying regarding the work of the FCHLPM. The Commission voted that no one is authorized to testify or speak on behalf of the Commission as a whole and that in any instance in which a member of the Commission, the Professional Team or anyone else is called to testify or to speak about the Commission, they are doing so as an individual who is a member of the Commission, the Professional Team or the staff. The Professional Team was directed to contact the FHCF staff attorney before speaking to the press.
