

**Meeting Summary<sup>1</sup>**  
**Florida Commission on Hurricane Loss Projection Methodology**  
**October 15, 2001**

1. Discussed letter received from Risk Management Solutions outlining the changes to the software in the RiskLink 4.2 release. The Commission found RiskLink 4.2 acceptable under the 2000 Standards.
2. Ron Iman, Professional Team Statistician, presented a Demonstration Uncertainty/Sensitivity Analysis for Modeling Hurricane Effects based upon the demo study completed by Ron Iman, Mark Johnson (Professional Team Statistician), and Tom Schroeder (Professional Team Meteorologist).
3. The Commission approved Module 3, Form F with modifications and the Guidebook as presented by the Professional Team.
4. The Commission delegated to Staff any necessary technical changes to the remaining portions of the Report of Activities.
5. Discussion was held on including Commercial Residential property in the modeling process. During next year's on-site visits, the Professional Team is to gather information to develop commercial residential standards and to provide input on standards at the 2002 standards committee meetings.
