

## State of Florida - Motor Fuel Tax Estimates

Projected Motor Fuel Tax collections are revised at least three times a year or as otherwise needed by the Revenue Estimating Conference. The February 2018, August 2018, December 2018, and new March 2019 estimates are provided below. A comparison between the new March 2019 estimates and the prior December 2018 estimates is also provided.
